

The Colour of Money

The paint colours that help sell your house... versus the ones that probably don't!

The world of estate agency is a useful guide in how to present a house at its most desirable. Flowers, mood lighting, elegant, classic décor and the smell of freshly baked cookies wafting through. In other words, home. So, if you're wanting to sell a property that requires a lick of paint, think carefully about the palette.

THE BEST

Neutral tones

Shades such as white, beige, light grey and taupe are universally appealing. They make spaces look larger, brighter, and allow potential buyers to envision their own furniture and style in the home. This is the no-brainer option, offering maximum neutrality to spark their imagination. However, this can feel ubiquitous in a flooded market.

Soft blues

Light blue tones, especially in bathrooms and bedrooms, are calming, often associated with cleanliness and tranquillity. The key is to keep it subtle and avoiding anything too kitsch such as maritime themes and seashell toilet seats.

Greens

Subtle greens essentially bring the outside in. This is particularly effective in urban areas where nature is scarce, and a rich olive shade or leafy hue can create a calming atmosphere. You can also add plants to offer that living element of colour.

Off-White

While you don't want to be that person obsessing between 'polar bear' and 'frost', off-white shades really do add warmth without being too imposing, creating a homely yet stylish mood. It's also worth investing in good quality paint with a high percentage of pigments and binders for key areas such as hallways and lounges.

THE WORST

Bold or dark colours

Deep reds, purples and dark browns can make rooms feel small, gloomy or overly personalised, which may turn off buyers. The key is to create a sunny, calm and welcoming space.

Bright colours

Vivid oranges, yellows or greens might overpower a space and make it difficult for viewers to imagine the home as their own. Also, buyers may be reluctant to pay the maximum for somewhere they need to do a costly repaint job, so tone it down.

Unusual colours

Strong pinks, bright blues or quirky accent walls can be a distraction and very off-putting for the average buyer. Remember, the point is not to present your personality, it's to appeal to the broadest market possible. So back off and embrace your most conventional side, because you can unleash the real you onto your next home.

Black

Why not just leave the chalk body outline and pentagram drawing on the floor? In other words, no. Just no.



A simple day out – perhaps factoring in a picnic, walk or nature trail – can feel like a proper seasonal marker for children.

GET INVOLVED IN SOMETHING HANDS-ON

Children remember what they do more than what they're given. Craft workshops, baking sessions, pottery painting or farm experiences give

kids something tactile and creative to focus on. Many local venues run short Easter holiday workshops designed specifically for younger age groups.

CREATE A MINI EASTER TRADITION

Not everything has to be an event. Families are increasingly creating their own small Easter rituals: a special breakfast, a spring walk on Easter morning, decorating eggs together, or visiting the same café or park each year. It's these repeated moments that can often provoke the most meaningful memories.

BALANCE TREATS WITH TIME TOGETHER

Chocolate is part of Easter, but so is shared time. Board games, film afternoons, outdoor play or helping to cook a meal together all help children associate Easter with connection, not just consumption.

Ultimately, Easter doesn't need to be expensive or over-planned. At its best, it's social, seasonal and shared – a chance to slow down, step outside, and give children experiences that feel joyful, grounding and just a little bit special.

Ginger Peanut Chicken

PREPARATION TIME:

20 mins + soaking and marinating time

COOKING TIME:

50 minutes

SERVES: 4

INGREDIENTS:

Ginger chicken

500g chicken, cut into small bite-sized chunks
Thum-sized piece of ginger, grated
3 spring onions, thinly sliced
Zest and juice of 1-2 limes
2 tbsps brown sugar
1-1/2 tsp salt
1 tbsp olive oil or avocado oil
2-3 cloves garlic, minced
50g chopped roasted peanuts (dry roasted are great)
20g coriander
Pak choi

Coconut Rice

250-30g Jasmine rice
1 tin coconut milk

METHOD

In an oven-proof dish (either non-metallic or stainless steel), mix the chicken with the ginger, half the spring onions, lime zest, brown sugar, salt, and oil. Marinate for 2 hours.

For fluffy coconut rice

Wash the rice until the water is quite clear, to remove the starch. This is important because coconut milk is thicker than water, so without washing, the rice will be gluey. Then let the rice soak for an hour.

Preheat the oven to 200°C/ 180°C fan / Gas 4. In a large oven proof saucepan combine the can of coconut milk with a can of water and bring the mixture to the boil. Then add the rice. Cover with foil and bake, for 40 minutes. Oven-cooking allows the rice to steam without scorching the base of the pot. After 40 minutes, remove the pan from the oven and leave to rest for 15 minutes. The rice will absorb any remaining moisture and become fluffy.

The ginger chicken

Heat a large frying pan or wok to medium-high heat. Add the marinated chicken to the pan (split it into 2-3 batches depending on the size of your wok). Don't stir the chicken too much, to allow it to develop a caramelised surface.

When all the chicken is cooked and caramelised, reduce the heat slightly and add the peanuts and garlic. Sauté for 3-5 minutes until the garlic is fragrant.

Add the coriander, the remainder of the spring onions, and the pak choi. Squeeze lime juice into the pan and season with more salt and pepper as needed.


